

Summary

Travel to Finland and to the Nordics compared to previous year and pre-pandemic

Border survey latest 12 months (Sep 2023 – Aug 2024) & summer season (Jun-Aug 2024)

- Foreign visitors made 4.8 million trips to Finland during the latest 12 months, and they spent 3.7 billion euros in Finland. Median length of stay was 4 nights and 72% of the visitors were travelling for leisure purposes.
- In summer 2024, the total number of trips to Finland decreased slightly compared to the previous summer, and slightly bigger share of the trips were daytrips.
 - However, there were more vacation/recreation travellers this summer than in 2023. They came more often from neighbouring countries and the
 median length of stay decreased by one day from the previous summer. As a result, their average spend per trip decreased even though spend
 per day was higher. This summer the share of holiday makers travelling with family or friends was clearly smaller than year before.
 - When comparing vacation/recreation travellers during this summer and last winter seasons, there were clearly more trips in summer, but the
 total spend was higher in winter as the visitors spent so much more per trip and per day and the median length of stay was also longer in winter.
 Travelling by plane is much more common during winter, so carbon footprint was lower and carbon efficiency (euros/CO2) better in summer
 season.

Registered overnights in Finland Jan-Aug 2024 & summer season (Jun-Aug 2024)

- Number of <u>registered</u> foreign overnights in Jan-Aug 2024 were 10% above the figures of previous year, but still 13% below prepandemic. The biggest source markets were Germany, Sweden, France, USA, UK, and the Netherlands.
- During summer season 2024, registered foreign overnights increased by 12% compared to summer 2023 but stayed 16% below summer 2019. Germany, Sweden, and USA were the biggest source markets. Helsinki region was clearly the most popular region for the summer stays, and overnights increased there by 22% compared to previous summer.



Summary

Travel to Finland and to the Nordics compared to previous year and pre-pandemic

Registered overnights in the Nordics Jan-Aug 2024 & summer season (Jun-Aug 2024)

- Total number of registered foreign overnights during Jan-Aug 2024 was 40.7 million, which was 6% more than same period last year and also 6% more than in 2019.
 - o Finland's share of foreign overnights has decreased from 13% in Jan-Aug/2019 to 10% in Jan-Aug/2024.
- During summer 2024, foreign overnights were highest in Sweden (8.5M; YoY +6%, vs. 2019 +4%), Denmark (7.5M; +4%, +17%), and Norway (5.4M; +3%, +3%). Finland had the highest relative growth (+12%) compared to previous summer. However, Finland and Iceland were the only Nordic countries which didn't reach summer 2019 figures.

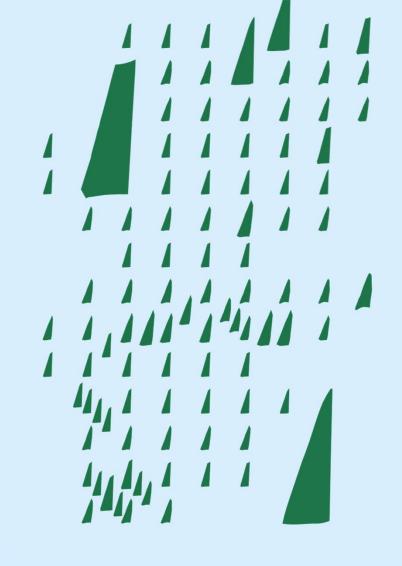
Flight capacity and bookings for autumn and winter seasons

- Flight capacity as well as bookings for the <u>autumn season</u> have increased to Finland, Sweden, and Norway compared to previous autumn. Current situation with the bookings shows even stronger growth than the growth with the flight capacity especially for Norway and Sweden.
- For the <u>winter season</u>, capacity is improving to Finland, Sweden and Norway compared to previous year, but it *remains slightly below pre-pandemic levels*. However, bookings are growing very strongly especially to Finland and Norway compared to both previous winter and *the winter before the covid years*.

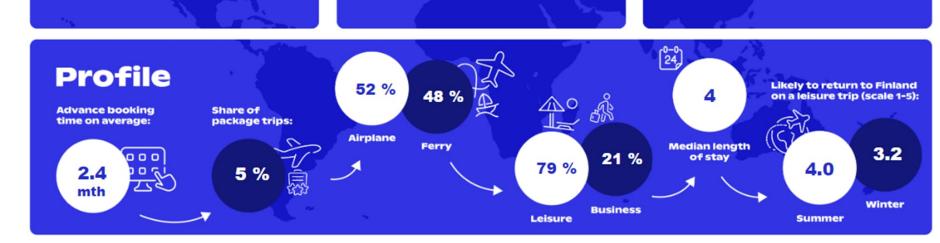
Per day:

- There were slightly less trips to Finland this summer than in 2023, and a slightly bigger share of the trips were day trips.
- Total spending decreased by 20% compared to previous summer even though the spend per day remained the same.
- As there were more visitors travelling by ferry and coming from nearby countries this summer, carbon footprint declined by 10% compared to summer 2023.

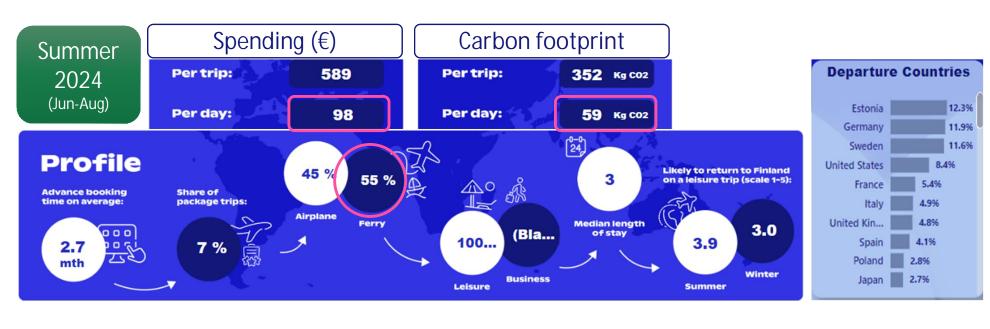

Comparison of vacation/recreation travel in summer high seasons 2024 vs. 2023

- Spend per trip of the vacation/recreation travellers was lower this summer than during the previous summer as the median length of stay was one day shorter. However, spend per day was higher.
- The share of vacation/recreation travellers coming from the neighbouring countries was also bigger this summer vs. summer 2023.

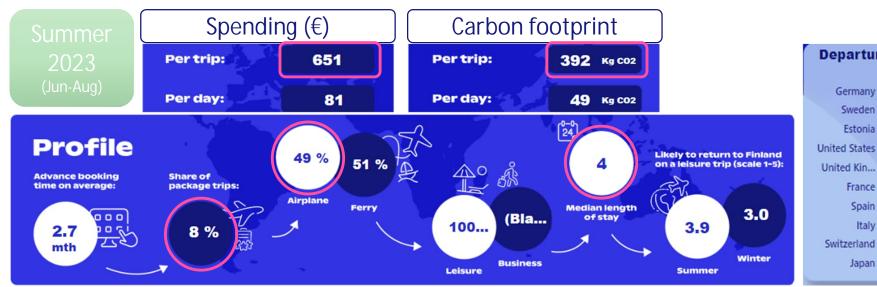

Comparison of vacation/recreation travel in summer high seasons

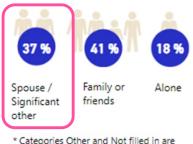

Even though there were more visitors travelling to Finland for vacation/ recreation this summer than in 2023, the total number of nights they spent here decreased as the median length of stay was shorter and there were less visitors travelling with family or friends.

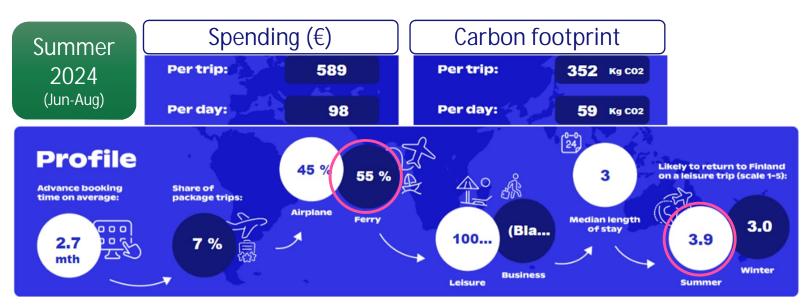
Bigger share of visitors coming here for vacation stayed in the Southern Finland.

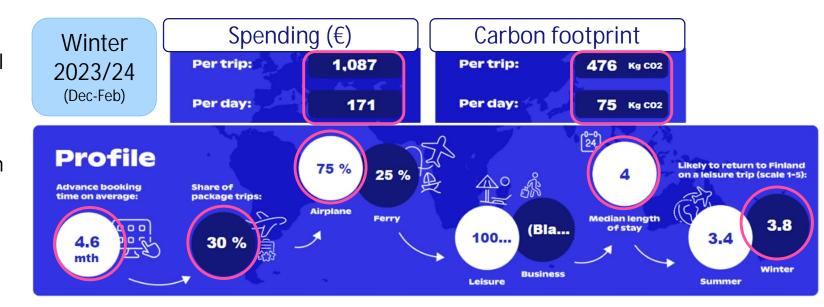


Comparison of <u>vacation/recreation</u> travel in <u>summer 2024</u> and <u>winter 2023/24</u> high seasons

- Vacation/recreation travellers made over 30% more trips to Finland during the summer season 2024 than during the winter season 2023/24.
- Even though the visitor numbers were so much bigger in summer, total spend of the visitors stayed on a nearly 30% lower level than in the winter. Average spend per trip and per day in summer were both over 40% less than during the winter season.
- Travelling by plane is clearly more common during the winter season, but as there are clearly more trips and the median length of stay is shorter during the summer season, total carbon footprint was only 3% lower in summer travel. However, average CO2/day was 21% lower in summer than in winter season, and Carbon efficiency (spending/CO2) was better in summer than in winter as bigger share of travellers come from nearby countries during the summer than during the winter season.

Registered overnights

January – August 2024

- Foreign overnights increased by 10% compared to previous year but remained 13% below the numbers of 2019. The biggest source markets were Germany, Sweden, France, USA, UK, and the Netherlands.
- Total accommodation revenue increased by 1% as the foreign revenue increased by 15% compared to Jan-Aug 2023 (domestic revenue -5%).

- o Top source markets: Germany, Sweden, USA

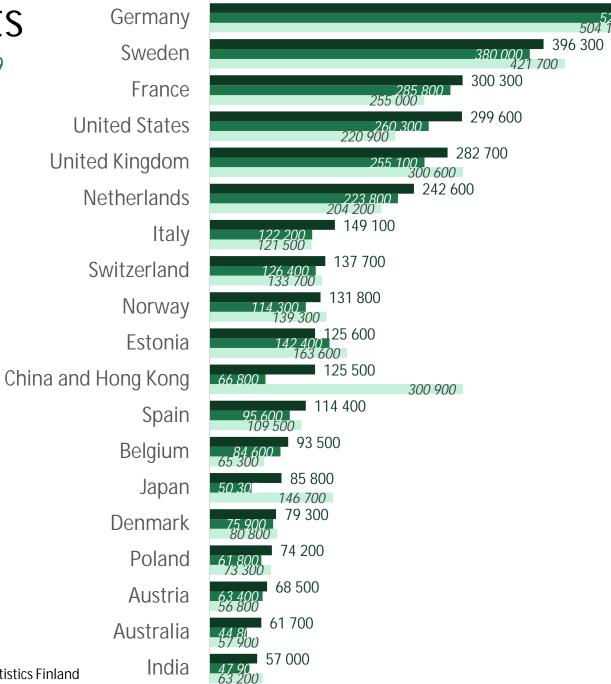

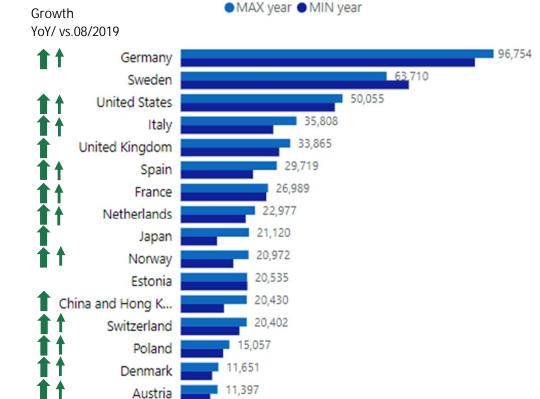

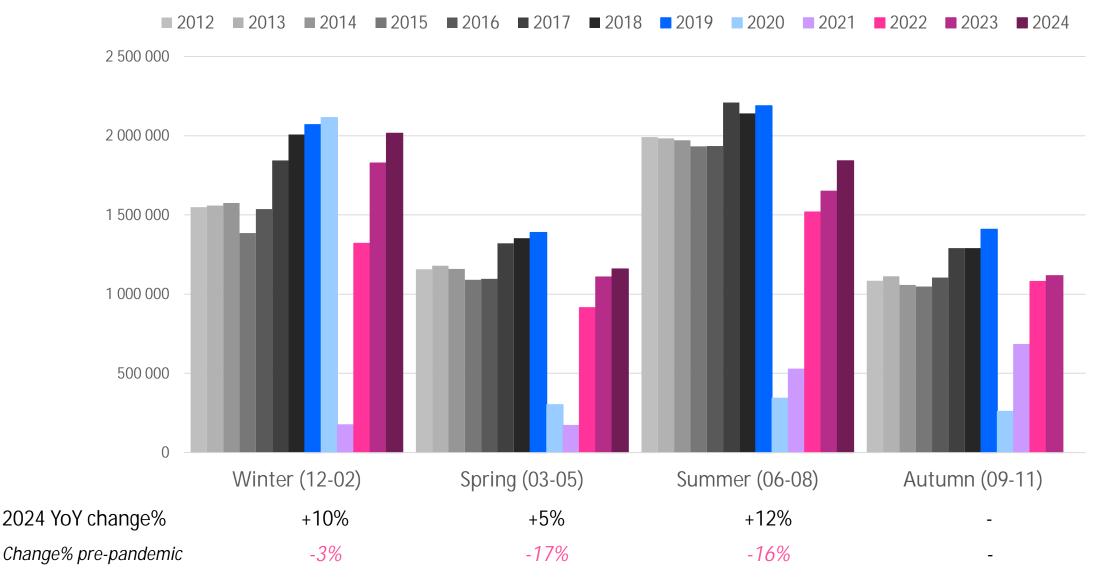
High summer season 2024

- o Foreign overnights increased by 12% compared to previous summer but remained 16% below the numbers of summer 2019.
- o The biggest source markets were Germany, Sweden, and USA.
 - Among the biggest source markets, summer overnights increased or were on the same level compared to previous year as well as to 2019 from USA, Norway, Switzerland, Poland, and Austria.
- Over half of the foreign overnights took place in Helsinki region, where overnights increased by 22% compared to previous summer and *stayed only 6% below summer 2019*.
- Overnights increased also in the Coast & Arhcipelago area compared to previous summer as foreign overnights increased especially in Turku, Oulu, and Kalajoki both compared to previous summer and *summer 2019*.
- In Lakeland and in Lapland region foreign overnights decreased both compared to previous summer and summer 2019.
 - However, compared to previous summer overnights increased in South Savo and Kainuu, as well as in Inari-Saariselkä, Kittilä-Levi, Kuusamo, Kemi-Tornio, Enontekiö, and Muonio. *In Kuusamo, overnights increased also compared to summer 2019*.

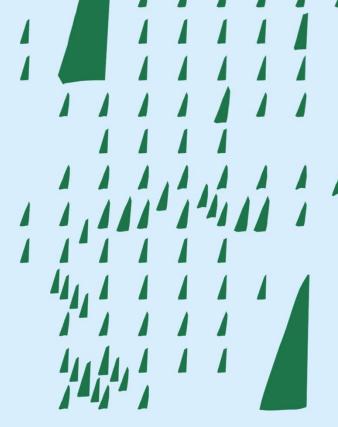

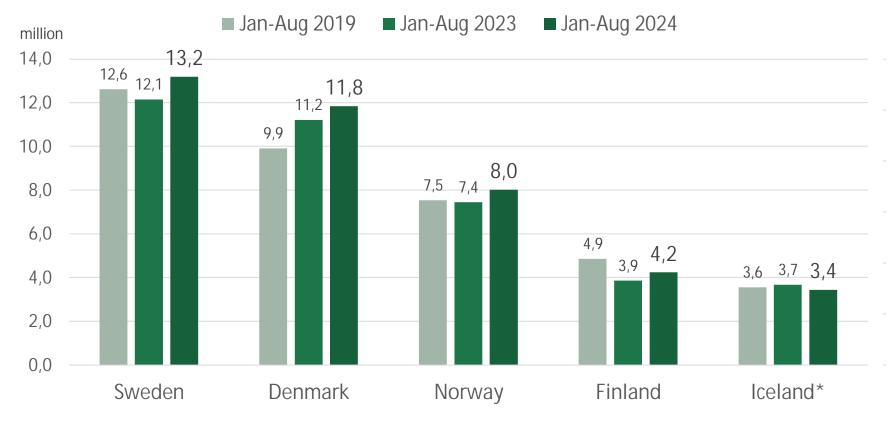


Summer (Jun-Aug) 2024

- Finland, with 1.8M foreign overnights, had the highest relative growth (+12%) compared to previous summer. However, Finland and Iceland were the only Nordic countries which didn't reach summer 2019 figures.
- Iceland was the only Nordic country where foreign overnights decreased compared to previous summer.



Cumulative foreign overnights in Nordics Jan-Aug

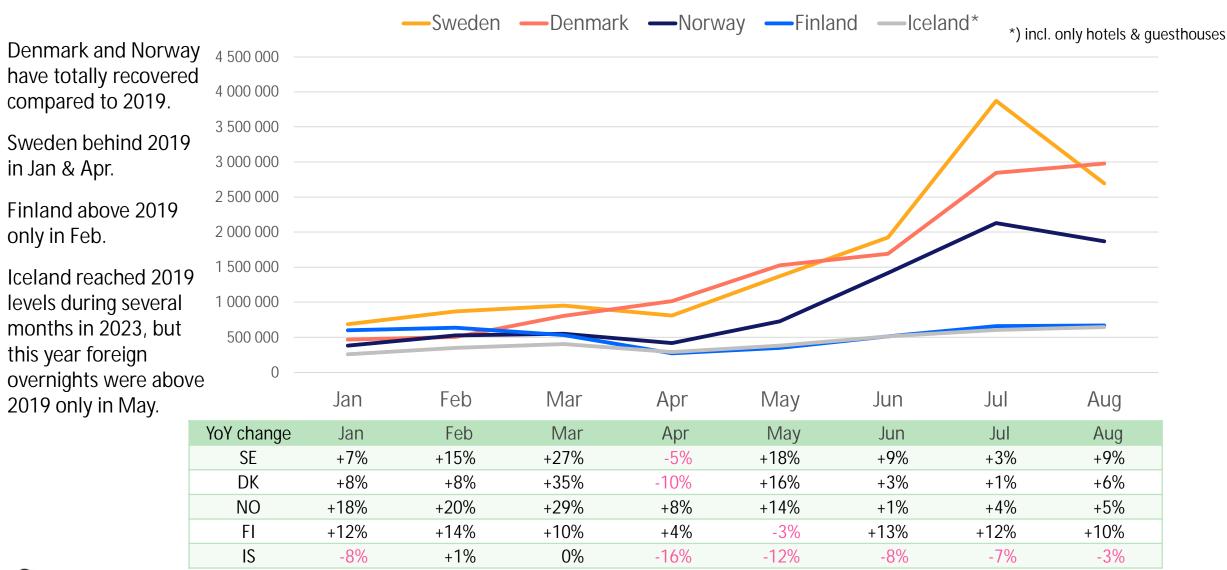

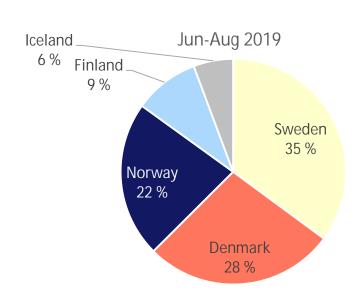

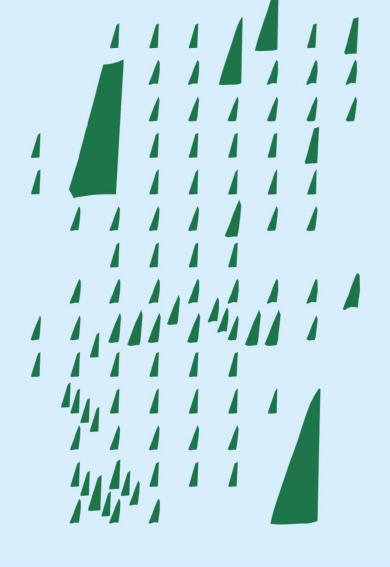




Flight capacity and bookings for autumn

Outlook for Sep-Nov 2024

- For the autumn season, capacity is improving especially to Finland when comparing to previous autumn. However, capacity to Finland and Sweden remains still 17% below the pre-pandemic level.
 - Capacity to Norway is already very close to autumn 2019.
- Flight bookings for the autumn months are growing compared to previous year to Finland, Sweden and Norway. Norway has the strongest growth and the bookings to Norway are already clearly above the levels of 2019.

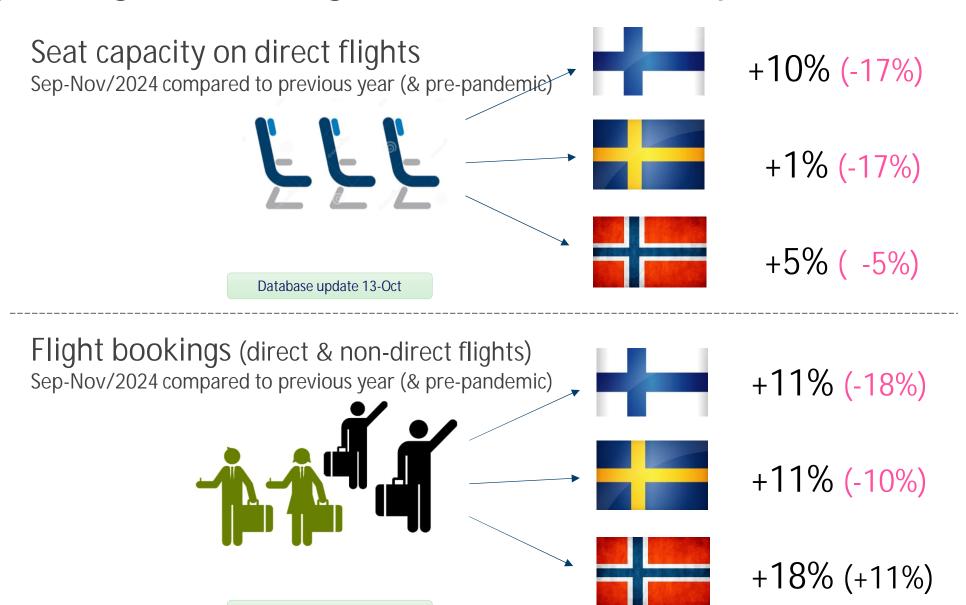




Seat capacity & flight bookings worldwide for Sep-Nov 2024

Seat capacity has increased the most to Finland compared to previous autumn, but it still remains clearly below pre-pandemic level. Capacity to Norway has recovered faster than capacity to Finland and Sweden.

Bookings of foreign visitors for autumn months have also increased compared to previous year. For Finland, the growth in bookings increases towards
November. Bookings to
Norway area growing strongly each of the autumn months even compared to pre-pandemic.



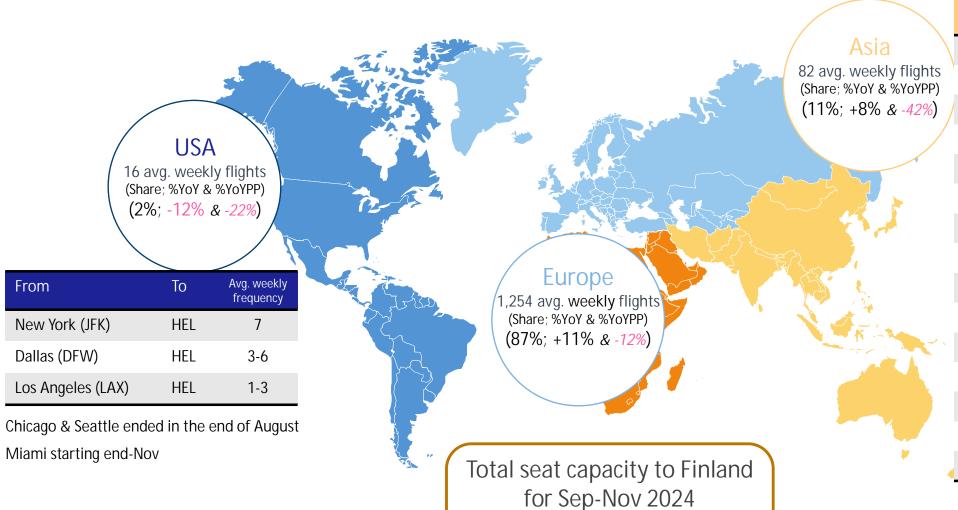


Direct int'l flights to Finland September – November 2024

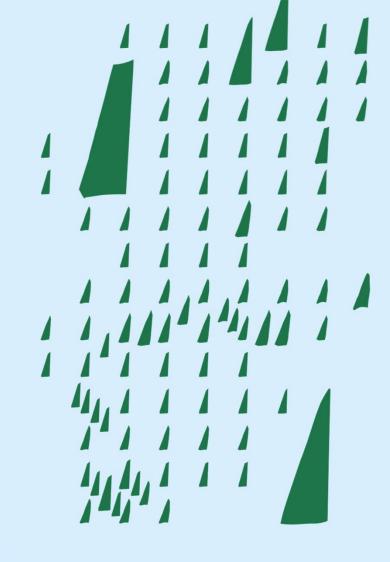

Flight capacity and bookings for winter

Outlook for Dec 2024 – Feb 2025

- For the winter season, capacity is improving especially to Finland and Norway compared to previous winter. It has come very close already the below pre-pandemic levels also in Finland and Norway.
 - Capacity to Sweden remains on the same level than last winter, so it still stays 24% below pre-pandemic levels.
- Demand for winter travel to the Nordics can clearly be seen in flight bookings which continue to grow strongly compared to both previous winter and the winter before the covid years.
 - ➤ Bookings made by the beginning of October shows that Finland is leading the way with nearly 130,000 bookings.
 - Winter bookings to Finland, Norway, and Sweden are growing from nearly all main source markets both compared to previous winter and to winter prepandemic.





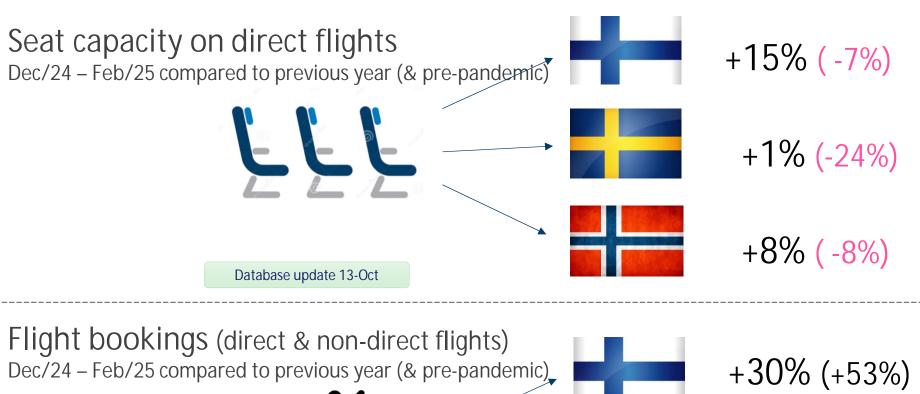
Seat capacity & flight bookings worldwide for Dec/2024 – Feb/2025

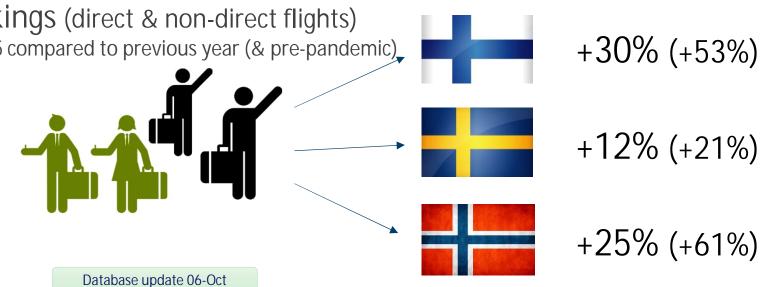
Seat capacity for winter months is increasing the most to Finland compared to previous winter, and it is also getting closer to the prepandemic level compared to other seasons.

Bookings of foreign visitors for winter have increased strongly both for Finland and Norway, so it seems that new records will be made this winter again in both countries. Bookings to Sweden show positive development as well.

It might also be that bookings are made earlier than before, so the pace of the growth might slow down towards the winter months.

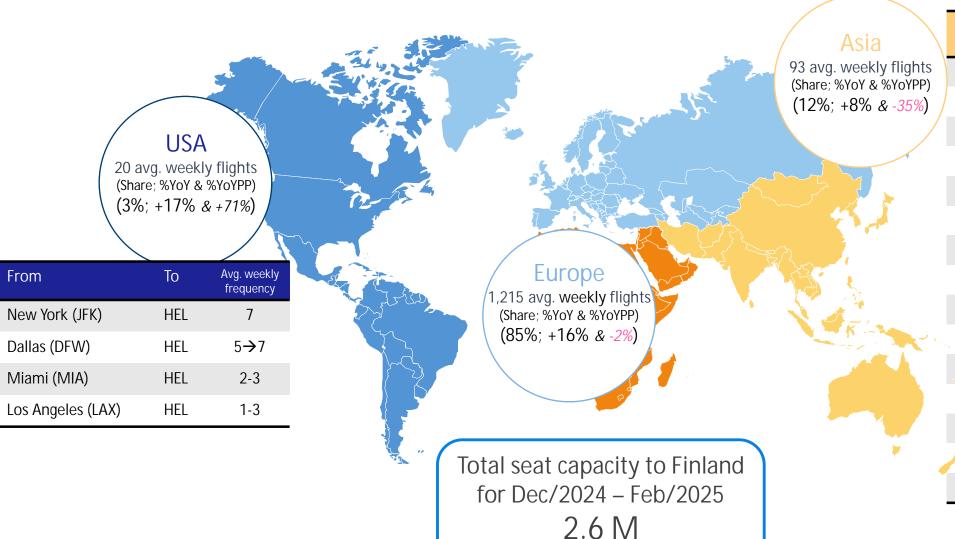






Direct int'l flights to Finland Dec/2024 – Feb/2025

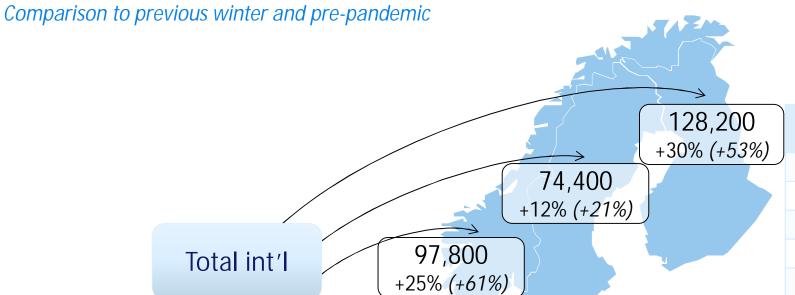
